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SUB GRANT AGREEMENT

The E-YUVA Fellow 1 to 5 altogether are hereinafter called as “E-YUVA Fellows”

And

Dr. Ashish M. Kothari S/o Mahendrabhai Nagjibhai Kothari permanent resident of 102, Balaji-4 Apartment, 1-Rajhans Society, Opposite SBI Raiya Road Branch, Rajkot - 360007, working as the Director Research Innovation and Technology at Atmiya University (hereinafter to be referred as “Institute”), having its registered address at Yogidham Gurukul" Kalawad Road, Rajkot-360005 Gujarat, Gujarat India, hereinafter to be referred as “**Mentor**” of the **Third Part**.

WHEREAS the Mentor is executing this agreement through its Institute. WHEREAS all the parts collectively to be referred as “Parties”;

WHEREAS, BIRAC has entrusted the E-YUVA Centre with the implementation of the E-YUVA Scheme on this E-YUVA Centre from initiation to closure of individual projects including necessary processing of the proposals, organizing various meetings and training programs, execution of the decisions taken, disbursement of funds, monitoring of the physical and financial progress of the Project and to obtain reports and returns and clarifications as required from time to time from the E-YUVA Fellows.

WHEREAS E-YUVA Fellows has been selected for E-YUVA Fellowship under the guidance of a mentor for the Research Project entitled “**Designing smart solutions for automatizing agricultural activities using IoT based embedded system**”, hereinafter to be referred as PROJECT and Appended hereto as **Annexure-1**



WHEREAS all the Annexures to this Agreement shall be read as an integral part of the Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE the Parties on valid consideration and mutual covenants enter into this SUB GRANT AGREEMENT, hereinafter to be referred as “SGA” as provided hereunder:

1. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE E-YUVA FELLOWS AND MENTOR

(a) The Mentor and E-YUVA Fellows shall:

- i. Carry out the activities of the Project under the mentorship of Mentor and conform to the specified objectives, outputs, milestones, and targets;
- ii. Meet the resources on the Project activities to the extent as agreed to, as per details given in **Annexure**.
- iii. The E-YUVA Fellows shall approach the Mentor for any project related expenditure required through Annual Research Grant.
- iv. The Mentor is authorized to make all project related expenditure or payments thereto, directly from the Institutes Account in which the Annual Research Grant is received.
- v. The Mentor shall submit a utilization certificate and statement of accounts at the following instances: -
 - Release of second installment of Annual Research Grant (Self Certified)
 - On completion of the Project (Certified by Institute’s finance department or another competent authority) and
 - On completion of half year ending 30th September and on completion of full year ending 31st March
- vi. Submit a milestone progress report to the E-YUVA Centre as per the timeline and participate in the meetings organized by Centre to review the progress of the Project, as and when called for;
- vii. Obtain all the necessary requisite approvals, clearance certificates, permissions and licenses from the Government/local authorities for conducting its operations in





connection with the Project;

- viii. The fellowship to EYUVA fellows will be released by the E-YUVA Centre directly to the savings bank account maintained by the name of each E-YUVA Fellow. The Mentor shall keep the Annual Research Grant (ARG) in the account of its Institute with a scheduled bank, the payments from which account shall be subject to verification by the E-YUVA Centre.
- ix. Utilize the ARG sanctioned by E-YUVA Centre for the purposes as specified in the Project and shall not entrust the implementation of the Project to another agency or divert the grant-in-aid assistance;
- x. Abide by the decision of E-YUVA Centre to modify the objectives, outputs, milestones, targets, and funding as also the foreclosure of the Project or of its components after mutual discussion;
- xi. Acknowledge the assistance of BIRAC while publishing or presenting in any manner the details of the Project, its progress or its success.
- xii. In the case of any ambiguity or conflict or inconsistency between this Agreement and any other associated agreement(s) entered into between E-YUVA Fellows and E-YUVA Centre on the same subject matter, the provisions of this Agreement shall take precedence.

(b) The Mentor and E-YUVA Fellows warrants that:

- i. Each shall obtain the prior consent of E-YUVA Centre in writing before entering into any agreement or arrangement with any other party, national or international, on the Project having overlapping objectives or having an impact on Intellectual Property for the Project duration;
- ii. Each is under no contractual restrictions or legal disqualifications or other obligations which will prohibit the E-YUVA Fellows from entering into this agreement or which will interfere with the execution of this agreement; and
- iii. Each and every one of the statements and particulars herein contained in this agreement and in the relevant and supporting documents to this agreement are correct.





2) The E-YUVA Fellows acknowledges and agree that:

The duties, responsibilities and functions assigned or entrusted to it as specified in the Project document shall be deemed to be the duties, responsibilities and functions assigned and entrusted under this Agreement and unless for reasons beyond control under normal circumstances any undue delay, failure or default in performance of the duties, responsibilities and functions as specified in the Project shall be deemed to be a default under this Agreement.

2. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE MENTOR

- i. The mentor shall oversee and supervise the E-YUVA Fellows activities during the project duration.
- ii. The mentor will supervise the mandatory visit of E-YUVA Fellows to E-YUVA Centre/ E-YUVA knowledge partners.
- iii. The mentor shall be responsible for managing the optimum utilization of the Annual Research Grant for the purpose of this project.
- iv. Release of quarterly fellowship to the E-YUVA Fellows will require prior approval of the Mentor.
- v. Verify and process the recommendation for release of the next quarterly fellowship, within 15 days of the upcoming/ applicable quarter.

3. FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

The financial arrangements under this Agreement are as here under

- i. The total fund approved by BIRAC and granted by E-YUVA Centre on behalf of BIRAC to E-YUVA Fellow towards the Project is as follows:
 - Annual Research Grant: Rs. 2,47,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh Forty Seven Thousand only).
 - o The annual research grant shall be released to the E-YUVA Centre's account and this will be further released to the account of Mentors Institute for further utilization/expenditure for the purpose of the project.
 - o The Annual Research Grant shall be used for the expenditures required to achieve the successful completion of the project such as travel, consumables,



etc.

- Quarterly Fellowship: Rs. 7500/- (Rupees Seven thousand five hundred only) per E-YUVA Fellow of the team on the terms and conditions detailed in this Agreement.
 - o Fellowship shall be released by the E-YUVA Centre directly to individual fellow's account on the recommendation of the Mentor within first 15 days of the quarter

ii. The annual research grant will be released in two installments as mentioned below:

- 1st Installment: 75%
- 2nd Installment: 25%

E-YUVA Centre shall release the first installment to the account of Mentor's Institute after signing of the Agreement and subject to the fulfillment of the terms and conditions for such release. Further release of funds shall be subject to satisfactory progress against the objectives, outputs, milestones and targets specified in the Project as determined by E-YUVA Centre and on submission of statement of accounts and utilization certificates.

- iii. The E-YUVA Fellows and mentor shall ensure that the funds of the Project are actually utilized only for the Project and as expressly provided in this Agreement.
- iv. The Mentor shall refund immediately any funds out of grant disbursed to it for the Project remaining unutilized with it on completion of the Project to E-YUVA Centre along with detailed accounts of funds received, utilized and unutilized;

4. E-YUVA MONITORING COMMITTEE (EMC)

E-YUVA Centre will constitute a E-YUVA MONITORING COMMITTEE (EMC) comprising of eminent expert(s) from the relevant field based on specific aspects of the Project. EMC will assess the progress of the Project in conformity with the outputs, milestones, targets and objectives as contained in the Agreement, will make recommendations accordingly and will provide mentorship and handholding services.

5. RESULTS OF THE PROJECT

- i. The deliverables from the Project are defined and included in the Project details at Annexure 1.



- ii. Any Intellectual Property (IP) developed out of this grant/ project shall be the SOLE PROPERTY of the E-YUVA Fellows only. It is the responsibility of the E-YUVA Fellows to protect any IP generated during the conduct of the Project. It shall bear the expenditure involved in protecting such IP. During the Project Duration, the E-YUVA Fellows shall not assign or transfer the IP to any third party directly or indirectly without prior written consent from E-YUVA Centre.

6. PROJECT DURATION

The Mentor and E-YUVA Fellows shall complete technical milestones of the Project within the stipulated period of 12 (Twelve) months after the date of execution of this Agreement. Subsequent to technical completion of the project, upto 3 months may be permitted for submission of financial documents & technical closure report to the E-YUVA Centre for final closure of the Project.

7. CONFIDENTIALITY

- i. During the tenure of the Agreement, the Parties undertake to maintain strict confidentiality and refrain from disclosure thereof, of all or any part of the information and data exchanged/generated from the Project under this Agreement for any purpose other than in accordance with this Agreement. It shall be the responsibility of the Parties to ensure maintenance of such confidentiality in respect of their behalf and on behalf of their employees, representatives and associates involved in the Project.
- ii. The Parties shall not have any obligation of confidentiality with respect to any information that:
- a. is in the public domain by use and/or publication at the time of its disclosure by the disclosing party; or
 - b. was already in possession of the recipient prior to receipt from the disclosing party; or
 - c. is properly obtained by the recipient from a third party with a valid right to disclose such information and such third party is not under confidentiality obligation to the disclosing party; or
 - d. was disclosed to any third party on a non-confidential basis prior to commencement





of the Project; or

e. is required by public authority, by law or decree.

8. FORECLOSURE:

- i. In case, during the tenure of the Project, it is found that the Project or any Project component is not likely to lead to successful completion, E-YUVA Centre may decide to foreclose the Project or the Project component as warranted. The decision of the E-YUVA Centre shall be final in all respects. The Mentor shall immediately refund any funds unutilized out of E-YUVA Centre's disbursements i.e. Annual Research Grant after deducting the legally committed expenses to third party vendors, to E-YUVA Centre etc., along with detailed accounts of funds received, utilized and unutilized within 30 days of such Foreclosure order. The entire outstanding amount as on the date of foreclosure will become due and payable immediately on issuance of the Foreclosure order by the E-YUVA Centre.

9. FORCE MAJEURE

The Parties shall not be held responsible for non-fulfillment of their respective obligations in successful completion of the Project under this Agreement due to the exigency of one or more of the force majeure events such as but not limited to acts of God, war, flood, earthquakes, strikes not confined to the premises of the Party, lockouts beyond the control of the Party claiming force majeure, epidemics, riots, civil commotion etc. lying beyond the reasonable control of and not brought about at the instance of the Party claiming to be affected by such event and which has caused the non-performance or delay in performance; provided on the occurrence and cessation of any such event the Party affected has given a notice in writing to the other Party within one month of such occurrence or cessation. If the force majeure conditions continue beyond six months, the Parties shall jointly decide about the future course of action on the Project. The validity of the claim of force majeure shall be determined by E-YUVA Centre after due enquiry and the decision in this regard shall be final.

10. DISPUTE RESOLUTION





In the event of any dispute or difference between the Parties hereto upon or in relation to or in connection with this Agreement, such dispute or difference shall be resolved amicably by mutual consultation or in presence of E-YUVA Centre. If the dispute is not resolved, then the same shall be referred to the Managing Director (MD), BIRAC for final resolution. Decision of MD BIRAC shall be final and binding on all parties.

11. EFFECTIVE DATE AND TENURE OF THE AGREEMENT

- i. The Agreement shall be valid for a period of 12 (twelve) months from the effective date. It can be extended if agreed to by both the Parties.
- ii. Original Agreement shall be signed by the Parties and one xerox copy each shall remain in the custody of each Party.

12. NOTICES AND JURISDICTION

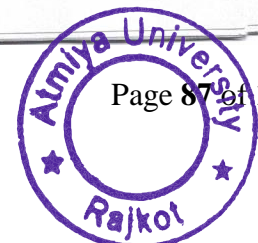

WHEREAS E-YUVA Fellows has been selected for E-YUVA Fellowship under the guidance of a mentor for the Research Project entitled “**Herbal Chocolate To Treat Menstrual Disorder**”, hereinafter to be referred as PROJECT and Appended hereto as **Annexure-1**

WHEREAS all the Annexures to this Agreement shall be read as an integral part of the Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE the Parties on valid consideration and mutual covenants enter into this SUB GRANT AGREEMENT, hereinafter to be referred as “**SGA**” as provided hereunder:



1. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE E-YUVA FELLOWS AND MENTOR

(a) The Mentor and E-YUVA Fellows shall:

- i. Carry out the activities of the Project under the mentorship of Mentor and conform to the specified objectives, outputs, milestones, and targets;
- ii. Meet the resources on the Project activities to the extent as agreed to, as per details given in **Annexure**.
- iii. The E-YUVA Fellows shall approach the Mentor for any project related expenditure required through Annual Research Grant.
- iv. The Mentor is authorized to make all project related expenditure or payments thereto, directly from the Institutes Account in which the Annual Research Grant is received.
- v. The Mentor shall submit a utilization certificate and statement of accounts at the following instances: -
 - Release of second installment of Annual Research Grant (Self Certified)
 - On completion of the Project (Certified by Institute's finance department or another competent authority) and
 - On completion of half year ending 30th September and on completion of full year ending 31st March
- vi. Submit a milestone progress report to the E-YUVA Centre as per the timeline and participate in the meetings organized by Centre to review the progress of the Project, as and when called for;
- vii. Obtain all the necessary requisite approvals, clearance certificates, permissions and licenses from the Government/local authorities for conducting its operations in connection with the Project;
- viii. The fellowship to EYUVA fellows will be released by the E-YUVA Centre directly to the savings bank account maintained by the name of each E-YUVA Fellow.
The Mentor shall keep the Annual Research Grant (ARG) in the account of its Institute with a scheduled bank, the payments from which account shall be subject to verification by the E-YUVA Centre.

- i. Each shall obtain the prior consent of E-YUVA Centre in writing before entering into any agreement or arrangement with any other party, national or international, on the Project having overlapping objectives or having an impact on Intellectual Property for the Project duration;
- ii. Each is under no contractual restrictions or legal disqualifications or other obligations which will prohibit the E-YUVA Fellows from entering into this agreement or which will interfere with the execution of this agreement; and
- iii. Each and every one of the statements and particulars herein contained in this agreement and in the relevant and supporting documents to this agreement are correct.

(c) The E-YUVA Fellows acknowledges and agree that:

- i. The duties, responsibilities and functions assigned or entrusted to it as specified in the Project document shall be deemed to be the duties, responsibilities and functions assigned and entrusted under this Agreement and unless for reasons beyond control under normal circumstances any undue delay, failure or default in performance of the duties, responsibilities and functions as specified in the Project shall be deemed to be a default under this Agreement.

- iv. Release of quarterly fellowship to the E-YUVA Fellows will require prior approval of the Mentor.
- v. Verify and process the recommendation for release of the next quarterly fellowship, within 15 days of the upcoming/ applicable quarter.

3. FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

The financial arrangements under this Agreement are as here under

- i. The total fund approved by BIRAC and granted by E-YUVA Centre on behalf of BIRAC to E-YUVA Fellow towards the Project is as follows:
 - Annual Research Grant: Rs. 2,50,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh Fifty Thousand only).
 - o The annual research grant shall be released to the E-YUVA Centre's account and this will be further released to the account of Mentors Institute for further utilization/expenditure for the purpose of the project.
 - o The Annual Research Grant shall be used for the expenditures required to achieve the successful completion of the project such as travel, consumables, etc.
 - Quarterly Fellowship: Rs. 7500/- (Rupees Seven thousand five hundred only) per E-YUVA Fellow of the team on the terms and conditions detailed in this Agreement.
 - o Fellowship shall be released by the E-YUVA Centre directly to individual fellow's account on the recommendation of the Mentor within first 15 days of the quarter
- ii. The annual research grant will be released in two installments as mentioned below:





- 1st Installment: 75%
- 2nd Installment: 25%

E-YUVA Centre shall release the first installment to the account of Mentor's Inst after signing of the Agreement and subject to the fulfillment of the terms and condit for such release. Further release of funds shall be subject to satisfactory progress ag the objectives, outputs, milestones and targets specified in the Project as determine E-YUVA Centre and on submission of statement of accounts and utilization certificate

iii. The E-YUVA Fellows and mentor shall ensure that the funds of the Project are actu utilized only for the Project and as expressly provided in this Agreement.

iv. The Mentor shall refund immediately any funds out of grant disbursed to it for Project remaining unutilized with it on completion of the Project to E-YUVA Cen along with detailed accounts of funds received, utilized and unutilized;

4. E-YUVA MONITORING COMMITTEE (EMC)

E-YUVA Centre will constitute a E-YUVA MONITORING COMMITTEE (EM comprising of eminent expert(s) from the relevant field based on specific aspects of Project. EMC will assess the progress of the Project in conformity with the outpu milestones, targets and objectives as contained in the Agreement, will ma recommendations accordingly and will provide mentorship and handholding services.

5. RESULTS OF THE PROJECT

- The deliverables from the Project are defined and included in the Project details Annexure I.
- Any Intellectual Property (IP) developed out of this grant/ project shall be the SOLE PROPERTY of the E-YUVA Fellows only. It is the responsibility of the E-YUV Fellows to protect any IP generated during the conduct of the Project. It shall bear th expenditure involved in protecting such IP. During the Project Duration, the E-YUV Fellows shall not assign or transfer the IP to any third party directly or indirect without prior written consent from E-YUVA Centre.

6. PROJECT DURATION





The Mentor and E-YUVA Fellows shall complete technical milestones of the Project within the stipulated period of 12 (Twelve) months after the date of execution of this Agreement. Subsequent to technical completion of the project, upto 3 months may be permitted for submission of financial documents & technical closure report to the E-YUVA Centre for final closure of the Project.

7. CONFIDENTIALITY

- i. During the tenure of the Agreement, the Parties undertake to maintain strict confidentiality and refrain from disclosure thereof, of all or any part of the information and data exchanged/generated from the Project under this Agreement for any purpose other than in accordance with this Agreement. It shall be the responsibility of the Parties to ensure maintenance of such confidentiality in respect of their behalf and on behalf of their employees, representatives and associates involved in the Project.
- ii. The Parties shall not have any obligation of confidentiality with respect to any information that:
 - a. is in the public domain by use and/or publication at the time of its disclosure by the disclosing party; or
 - b. was already in possession of the recipient prior to receipt from the disclosing party; or
 - c. is properly obtained by the recipient from a third party with a valid right to disclose such information and such third party is not under confidentiality obligation to the disclosing party; or

8. FORECLOSURE:

- i. The decision of the E-YUVA Centre shall be final in all respects. The Mentor shall immediately refund any





funds unutilized out of E-YUVA Centre's disbursements i.e. Annual Research Grant, after deducting the legally committed expenses to third party vendors, to E-YUVA Centre etc., along with detailed accounts of funds received, utilized and unutilized within 30 days of such Foreclosure order. The entire outstanding amount as on the date of foreclosure will become due and payable immediately on issuance of the Foreclosure order by the E-YUVA Centre.

9. FORCE MAJEURE

The Parties shall not be held responsible for non-fulfillment of their respective obligations in successful completion of the Project under this Agreement due to the exigency of one or more of the force majeure events such as but not limited to acts of God, war, flood, earthquakes, strikes not confined to the premises of the Party, lockouts beyond the control of the Party claiming force majeure, epidemics, riots, civil commotion etc. lying beyond the reasonable control of and not brought about at the instance of the Party claiming to be affected by such event and which has caused the non-performance or delay in performance; provided on the occurrence and cessation of any such event the Party affected has given a notice in writing to the other Party within one month of such occurrence or cessation. If the force majeure conditions continue beyond six months, the Parties shall jointly decide about the future course of action on the Project. The validity of the claim of force majeure shall be determined by E-YUVA Centre after due enquiry and the decision in this regard shall be final.

10. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

In the event of any dispute or difference between the Parties hereto upon or in relation to or in connection with this Agreement, such dispute or difference shall be resolved amicably by mutual consultation or in presence of E-YUVA Centre. If the dispute is not resolved, then the same shall be referred to the Managing Director (MD), BIRAC for final resolution. Decision of MD BIRAC shall be final and binding on all parties.

11. EFFECTIVE DATE AND TENURE OF THE AGREEMENT

- i. The Agreement shall be valid for a period of 12 (twelve) months from the effective date.
