Report on Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) Activities

Activity 01 Adoption of Villages Date: 11/08/2023

Atmiya University has been selected as a Participating Institution under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, a flagship program of the Ministry of Education (MoE), Government of India. We have adopted a cluster of 5 villages namely Rampara Beti, Saypar, Kuchiyadad, Mesvada and Parevala under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) in collaboration with the District Collectors.

After registration and selection of the institutes under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan a token amount of INR 10,000 per village is released under the UBA program. The funds are mainly meant for assistance for awareness, Gram Panchayat Development Plan (GPDP) study, need assessment, and contingency expenditure.

Seed funding of INR 50,000 is disbursed to Atmiya University, for conducting the village survey. We would be completing the survey of all the 5 villages very soon for identifying major issues and preparing action plans or technical interventions with the help of village development officer.
