Anganwadi centers are part of the Indian government's Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) program, which aims to provide basic health care, nutrition, and pre-school education to children under six years old, as well as to pregnant women and lactating mothers. The term "anganwadi" translates to "courtyard shelter" in Hindi, reflecting the centers' typical location within a village or community.

**Key Functions and Services of Anganwadi Centres:**

1. **Supplementary Nutrition:**
  - o Provide nutritious meals to children under six, as well as to pregnant and lactating women.
  - o Help combat malnutrition and ensure proper growth and development.
2. **Pre-school Education:**

3. **Health Check-ups and Immunization:**

  - o Promote breastfeeding and appropriate weaning practices.
5. **Referral Services:**
  - o Identify children and mothers in need of additional medical attention and refer them to appropriate health facilities.
6. **Growth Monitoring:**
  - o Track the growth and development of children using growth charts.
  - o Provide counseling to parents on nutrition and health care based on the growth data.

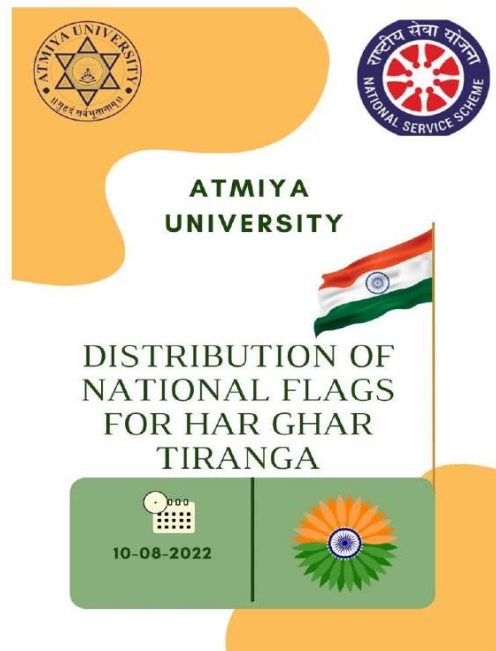
