Anganwadi centers are part of the Indian government's Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) program, which aims to provide basic health care, nutrition, and pre-school education to children under six years old, as well as to pregnant women and lactating mothers. The term "anganwadi" translates to "courtyard shelter" in Hindi, reflecting the centers' typical location within a village or community.

Key Functions and Services of Anganwadi Centres:

1. Supplementary Nutrition:

- Provide nutritious meals to children under six, as well as to pregnant and lactating women
- Help combat malnutrition and ensure proper growth and development.

2. Pre-school Education:

- o Offer early childhood education to children aged 3-6 years.
- Prepare children for primary school through activities that promote cognitive and social development.

3. Health Check-ups and Immunization:

- Conduct regular health check-ups for children and women.

6. Growth Monitoring:

- o Provide counseling to parents on nutrition and health care based on the growth
