

However, during the actual pitch-ins they found it difficult to make a case out of their proposition. Some of

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






Preamble

The Atmiya University (AU), herein referred to as "AU", an institution of higher learning established on April 13, 2018, under the Gujarat Private University Act 11, 2018, with principal office address at "Yogidham Gurukul", Kalawad Road, Rajkot - 360005, (Gujarat), India. The motto "Suhardam Sarva Bhootanam" is an expression of willingness to attain harmony with each creation of the almighty. His Divine Holiness Hariprasad Swamiji Maharaj the present spiritual successor of Lord Swaminarayn is the mentor of Attmiya University. With his blessing, His Divinity P.P. Tyagvallabh Swamiji has envisioned of Atmiya University to be a global leader in showing the path to enshrine Jeevan Vidya into every domain area of higher education.

The Lincoln University College (LUC), herein referred to as "LUC", Petaling Jaya, Malaysia was established in the year 2002 as Lincoln College (LC) and upgraded to Lincoln University College in the year 2011. Lincoln University College is one of the premier private institutions of higher education approved by the Ministry of Higher Education and Malaysian Qualifying Agency (MQA- National Accreditation Board). Lincoln University College received 5 Star Ranking (Setara 5) by Ministry of Education, Government of Malaysia and 80th in Quality Education as per THE (Times Higher Education) Impact Ranking 2020. Lincoln University College is also the associate member of the, Association of Commonwealth Universities (ACU), London and a member of "International Association of Universities (AIU)" Paris, duly represented by herein by its President, Dr. Amiya Bhaumik.

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The parties have well established reputation in teaching and research and allied fields and consider international links and collaboration as essential component to strengthen program delivery and governance.

Purpose

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is designed to foster a friendly relationship through mutual cooperation in teaching, research, and extension activities between AU and LUC.

Atmiya University, Rajkot India, and Lincoln University College, Malaysia, are signing this Agreement in order to promote academic exchanges in education and research.

- Under the existing law and other government rules and regulations of each country, both universities agree for mutual academic capacity building in various areas of education and research on the basis of equality and reciprocity:
 - (1) Exchange of researchers, faculty members and other research staff
 - (2) Conducting collaborative research projects and organizing symposia
 - (3) Exchange of research data and materials of joint research work
 - (4) Collaborative Online Interaction Learning (COIL)
 - (5) Co-Guide ship by faculty members
 - (6) Joint consultancy
- Specific details on the development and implementation of particular exchanges noted above shall be negotiated and agreed between both universities, and carried out in accordance with the memorandum.
- Expenses to be incurred in the implementation of this Agreement shall be the responsibility of each university, unless another arrangement is agreed upon by both universities.
- Symposium hosted by each university. Any more professional bodies or university would like to associate with mutual concern.
- Neither university shall be liable for any failure or delay to perform its part of this Agreement when such failure is due to Act of God, war, armed conflict, civil disturbance,

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legal restrictions, riots, insurrections, strikes, an earthquake, flood, fire, pandemic disease or any cause beyond the control of the universities; provided that a written notice of the commencement and cessation of the circumstances excusing performance shall be submitted as quickly as possible.

- 6. This Agreement shall not be construed as any transfer assignment or infringement of any intellectual property between the two universities, unless joint research work is done. Any necessary assignment or transfer of intellectual property or materials will be decided by the department involved at each institution and carried out in accordance with a separate agreement or contract, based on strict compliance with the relevant laws and treaties of the country concerned. When results are patentable such publication will be carried only after the consent of all interested parties.
- 7. This agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India or Malaysia depending on where the implementation of the Agreement will take place. Each exchange participant shall be made aware that in a case where he or she violates the laws of the host country, the host university shall bear no responsibility for the person's actions.

Confidentiality Agreement

The parties agree that all information including business information and research results transmitted during the term of this MOU and five years thereafter shall be deemed confidential and shall not without the prior consent of the disclosing party be used or disclosed to third party except those information that are already made public, or information that will be made available to the public by both parties.

Dispute of Resolution

Any dispute arising from this MOU shall be amicably resolved through consultation or negotiation between parties or such other means as the parties may decide.

Nonbinding Agreement

This MOU creates no right, benefit, or trust responsibility, substantive or procedural enforceable at law or equity. Each party operates under its own laws, regulations and policies subject to the availability of funds and resources.

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Amendment

No amendment, consent or waiver of terms of this MOU shall bind either party unless in writing and signed by all parties. Any such amendment, consent or waiver shall be effective only in the specific instance for the specified purpose given. The parties to this MOU, by the signatures below of their authorized representatives, acknowledge having read and understood this MOU and agree to be bound by its terms and conditions.

Term of MOU

This MOU shall commence on the date of latest signature and be in effect for 2 years, at which time it shall be reviewed for possible extension. However, such notification must be received by the other party at least six months prior to the effective date of termination.
