#### Purpose:

The main objective of the Day Care Centre is to provide faculty and staff members with peace of mind while they focus on their professional responsibilities. It is also a key part of the university's broader approach to inclusivity, gender equity, and promoting a healthy work-life balance.

### Services and Facilities:

- Age-appropriate Care: The Day Care Centre is designed to cater to children from infants
  up to the age of 08 years, with age-specific care plans, activities, and routines.
- Well-Trained Staff: The Centre is staffed with experienced caregivers and child development specialists who ensure that the children receive quality care, early learning, guidance and emotional support.
- Safety and Hygiene: The safety of the children is of paramount importance. The Centre is
  equipped with child-proofing features, and staffs' adheres to strict hygiene and safety
  protocols. This promotes physical well-being and instils good habits.
- 4. Learning and Play: Recreational & Educational activities are tailored to the developmental stage of each child. Infants engage in sensory exploration, while toddlers and preschoolers participate in activities promoting cognitive, social, and motor skills. Examples include storytelling, music, art & craft, and simple puzzles.
- Nutritional Care: The children are provided with nutritious meals, snacks, naps and play time during the day, ensuring that they are well-nourished and managed.
- 6. Flexible Hours: The Centre operates during university working hours, with some flexibility to accommodate the schedules of faculty and staff.

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Parental Access: Parents are encouraged to visit the Centre during breaks to meet and get regular updates about their ward. There is also an open communication line for parents to monitor their child's progress and well-being.

### Impact on Faculty and Staff:

- 1. Improved Work-Life Balance: By offering this service, Atmiya University helps its employees manage their professional and personal responsibilities more effectively by spending time with their child during breaks.

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

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
